- Prepared to worship and minister in the Church of England
- In paid employment for a minimum of 20hrs a week (We may be able to assist you in finding employment if you are not already employed nearby)
- In possession of a full driving licence

All members of the Charlecote Community will be expected to:

- Contribute to utility bills and food, but there will be no rent to pay
- Participate fully in running the community house – cooking, cleaning, gardening etc.
- Lead and participate in community prayer, worship & bible study
- Offer a minimum of 5 hours a week to mission and ministry in the local churches, primary schools and/or college.
