What is the Glebe Committee?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Committee manages the land and properties which the Diocese of Coventry owns. This is approximately 3,000 acres of agricultural land and a number of commercial and residential properties with significant asset value.
Member's credentials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To have expertise in financial and land management matters in a professional capacity (such as professional experience in property investment, land management or experience in running a business) Be willing to serve the Diocese using your professional expertise.
Commitment required from members	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To attend 6 meetings per year, lasting up to 2 and half hours, which are held during normal working hours via Zoom. To read meeting papers which are sent a week prior to the meeting. Once a year the Committee meets for a full day to enable them to visit a selection of properties under its management. The commitment is for 3 years and travel expenses will be reimburse
